5. Announcements and updates from subcommittee members
Krista shared Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month campaign "Love Is Not Control," developed by RICADV in partnership with PPSD and others.
Krista shared Teen Ice Skating event on February 26th – free for ages 13-21.
Connor shared positive outcome of connecting with a Health teacher through Subcommittee contact and how that led to AIDS Project RI doing a presentation at Highlander Charter School in Warren.

PRESENTATIONS

6. Teen Dating Violence in Rhode Island - Krista D'Amico
We briefly discussed the data due to time constraints. Data comes from most recent (2017) Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) data in Rhode Island. YRBS is based on random sampling of schools statewide.
DOH analyzed the data for RICADV to look at disparities as well as interconnectedness of health risk behaviors, including issues related to violence, safety, substance use, and mental health.

7. Discussion relative to Resource Guide promotion
Resource Guide outreach – HCO has offered to use funding to print business card-like piece to share the link to the Resource Guide and what it is/how it can be used.
 - We already have the language for this on the RG itself, just need a graphic to help make it stand out.
 - Gabriela (BRUSHE) volunteered to draft; Krista and Jennifer will then seek input from students on the design
 - Note: Connor offered connection with design group that does APRI materials; highly recommends, if needed.
 - Subcommittee will further discuss plan for more effective outreach of RG in general. (NEARI website? Jola)

8. Discussion relative to Wellness Policy addendum
Wellness Policy amendment
 - There is concern that it might get lost in the larger Wellness Policy and be an odd fit since the rest of policy focuses on nutrition and physical activity.
 - Should the amendment be a stand-alone instead?
 - Solight and Sara will review other policies from district to see if there would be a better match for placement or a model to create a new stand-alone policy.

9. Review new goals for subcommittee
 - 1) **Define, communicate, and build awareness about Healthy Relationships Subcommittee and the work the Subcommittee is involved with or promotes.**
 - 2) **Increase the presence and engagement of stakeholders, including Health teachers, parents, families, students, and school/district administrators.**

 - Aligned with defined role of H&W Committee as outlined in the PPSD Wellness Policy: advising on curriculum; assisting with development & implementation of policy in the schools, assessing implementation
